Child-resistant packaging

In order for a packaging to be deemed child-resistant, it must be tested, assessed and certified in accordance with the international ISO 8317 standard by an accredited test institute. It is always the complete packaging, in combination, that must be approved, not just the cap or closure. There is nothing that regulates who should hold this certificate for child-resistant packaging, but we have chosen to include this in our offer – to offer “packaging that makes life easier!”

All of our caps and closures with child-resistant functions are therefore tested and certified in accordance with current applicable standards – this in combination with the majority of bottles to which we have access, primarily on the Scandinavian market.

Over and above the certificate, the party responsible for the final product must ensure that the child-resistant function is maintained throughout the whole of the life-cycle of the packaging (SS-EN-ISO 8317, point 4.2). As the content and requirements for the product can vary, it is not possible for us to guarantee this. We can make recommendations and provide certain guide lines – but it is your responsibility to ensure that the child-resistant function is maintained based on your requirements and the requirements of the product.

Annual review

In order to maintain and keep the certificates up to date, an annual update and supplementary addition is made with new bottles, caps and closures. This means that every year, we have a formal check and review with our customers to ensure that the packaging being used is covered by our certificate.

Before you carry out a change of an alteration to a bottle, this should always be preceded by information to us to ensure that the packaging continues to be covered by our certificate. Contact your sales person in order to register an alteration message.

We recommend that you, on the packaging, state that it has a child-resistant certificate.

Include your packaging on our certificate

We offer all our customers the opportunity to include their child-resistant packaging on our certificate.

By providing information about the bottles that you use, we can, after assessment with our test institute, add an addendum to the certificate. The criterion for this to be possible, however, is that the bottle is judged to be included in the selection carried out regarding the volume of the bottle, the raw material as well as the screw thread.
